Historic Downtown Brevard, cradled by the Pisgah National Forest, is the safe, walkable center of our community. Lined with diverse independent businesses, downtown serves as the crossroads to exceptional outdoor recreation and is a thriving hub for the arts.

WELCOME TO DOWNTOWN

This year, Heart of Brevard has been all about progress, growth, and the power of partnership. Our 2024 Annual Report is a celebration of the strides we've made together—a testament to what's possible when a community comes together with shared purpose and determination.

Downtown Brevard is so much more than a collection of buildings or a destination on a map-it's the heart of our community. It's where stories are told, dreams are realized, and neighbors gather. It's where history and innovation intertwine, creating a place that's as unique as it is welcoming. We believe that a thriving downtown is essential to the well-being of our entire community, and every step we take is in service of that belief. We moved into a new office suited to our expanding work and deepened partnerships with the City of Brevard, officials, and downtown stakeholders to enhance public spaces, support local businesses, and keep downtown thriving. This year, we've grown stronger and more connected as an organization.

We made meaningful progress on several long-term projects, including the Loretta Mary Aiken Mural, a part of the NC Music Mural Project, which beautifully blends history and art. The Public Art Process is setting the stage for future creative projects. During the Times Arcade Alley Stormwater Project, we worked closely with businesses and city planners, ensuring these crucial infrastructure improvements kept downtown accessible and welcoming.

In 2024, our community demonstrated incredible resilience. After Hurricane Helene, we served on the Transylvania Tomorrow Task Force, raising over \$420,000 to support small businesses. Halloweenfest took on a new dimension with a community concert, which raised critical funds and reinforced the connections that drive us forward.

Our efforts to support businesses have never been stronger. We updated our Shopping and Dining Guide, improved signage, and developed vendor maps for events. The launch of the Social District in February added vibrancy to downtown, creating more opportunities for connection.

Our events, including the 20th Anniversary White Squirrel Weekend and Halloweenfest, drew record crowds, energized the local economy, and brought joy to thousands. These events define our downtown and strengthen community bonds.

We are grateful for the partnerships that made 2024 possible. Sponsors, volunteers, local leaders, and supporters helped us achieve so much. Together, we've shown that downtown Brevard isn't just the heart of our community—it's the soul of what makes Brevard extraordinary.

OPERATIONAL IMPROVEMENTS

Celebrated our **30th Anniversary Year** as a Designated North Carolina Main Street Organization.

Secured a **New Office Space** to support the organization's growth and operational needs.

DESIGN + INFRASTRUCTURE

Facilitated the completion of the Loretta Mary Aiken Mural,

highlighting local history as part of the NC Music Mural Project.

Completed our **3rd Annual Walkable Center Assessment** and presented to council resulting in \$30,000 in funds for addressing the safety and infrastructure improvements in the HOB district.

BUSINESS SUPPORT + VISITOR ENGAGEMENT

Since its launch in April 2024, the **Social District**, with 27 participating businesses, has generated an estimated economic impact of \$127,500 from approximately 19,500 stickered beverages sold (\$97,500) and 6,000 beverages sold during White Squirrel Weekend (\$30,000).

HURRICANE HELENE RESPONSE + RECOVERY

♥ In response to the catastrophic impacts of Hurricane Helene, Transylvania Business Support Task Force has relaunched the Transylvania Tomorrow Small Business Emergency Relief Fund (Transylvania Tomorrow) to support the small business community in Transylvania County, NC.

Partnered with the Transylvania Tomorrow Task Force to raise over \$400k, supporting 58 businesses through grants in Transylvania County.

MAIN STREET

NC Main Street is part of the Main Street America[™] network, which helps communities strengthen their downtowns. It works with over 40 Coordinating Programs and 1,200 communities across the country to boost local economies and preserve historic areas through preservationbased economic development.




COMMUNITY SUPPORT
